guidelines

Women In Film and Television - Toronto is currently accepting applications for the Kodak New Vision Mentorship, presented in partnership with Kodak Canada Entertainment Imaging.

This national initiative provides one exceptional Canadian female director with the invaluable opportunity to prepare for the 2008 Toronto International Film Festival (TIFF), September 2008, through intensive industry coaching and a TIFF bursary, followed by a two month creative mentorship with an established director.

mentorship benefits

The Kodak New Vision Mentorship winner receives the following benefits

- \$5,000 in-kind donation of Kodak Motion Picture film stock
- preparation for the 2008 Toronto International Film Festival with a seasoned industry professional
- one-on-one, two month post-TIFF mentorship with an established director
- complimentary TIFF registration and access to professional seminars and training at the festival
- announcement of award winner at the WIFT-T Reception @ TIFF on September 11, 2008
- award presentation at the Crystal Awards Gala Luncheon on December 1, 2008
- guidance for post-TIFF follow-up



eligibility requirements

Candidates must meet the following criteria to be eligible for consideration:

- be a Full or Associate WIFT-T member (may join at time of application);
- be a Canadian citizen or permanent resident;
- be a female director;
- must have a minimum of one feature film project in development, with a finished script
- had at least one film (short or feature) screened, or screening, in at least one of the following festivals:
 - Toronto International Film Festival
 - Montreal World Film Festival
 - National Screen Institute - Film Exchange
 - CFC World Wide Short Film Festival
 - Reel World Film Festival
 - Inside Out Film Festival
 - Yorkton Film Festival
 - Vancouver International Film Festival
 - Atlantic International Film Festival
- must be able to participate in the mentorship sessions;
- must attend award announcement (September 11, 2008) at the WIFT-T Reception @ TIFF and the award presentation ceremony at the Crystal Awards (December 1, 2008);
- must complete Final Report.

application process

Eligible candidates are invited to apply to the program (see Application Form). **Deadline for applications is Tuesday, August 5, 2008 at 12 pm EST.** Applications will be reviewed by a selection committee composed of industry representatives. The award winner will be notified prior to TIFF and the official announcement will be made on September 11, 2008 at the WIFT-T Reception @ TIFF.

PLEASE NOTE: A \$25 administration fee, paid by credit card or cheque, will be required to process your application. Incomplete applications will not be considered.
